Tranche 1 of City funding totaling \$50 million was approved under ordinance 2023-114 and has previously been appropraited. Tranche 2, as approved by the subject ordinance, will be appropriated over a consecutive four (4) year basis commencing October 1, 2027, in the amount of \$12.5 million, with \$12.5 million of additional funding being requested for appropraition in each of the three consecutive years, capped in the aggregate over such 4-year period at \$50 million. All funds will be disbursed in reimbursement of funds expended for the direct costs of campus development activity as defined in the redevelopment agreement.
