AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NEW SECTION 106.330.1 (PROHIBITION ON EXPENDITURES FOR ABORTIONS AND/OR RELATED SERVICES), SUBPART B (SPECIAL PROVISIONS), PART 3 (APPROPRIATIONS), CHAPTER 106 (BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO PROHIBIT EXPENDITURE OF CITY FUNDS TO PAY FOR ABORTIONS AND/OR RELATED SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

1. Summary of the proposed ordinance (must include a statement of the public purpose, such as serving the public health, safety, morals, and welfare):

This Ordinance amends the City of Jacksonville Code of Ordinances to include a prohibition on the expenditure of City funds to pay for abortions and/or related services. This serves the public interest by redirecting potential expenditures of City/taxpayer dollars from services that would not be categorized as core government functions.
