5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$411,625.25 GRANT  
6 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY,  
7 FUNDED THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT  
8 PROGRAM AND APPROVED BY THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF  
9 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR THE PURCHASE AND  
10 INSTALLATION OF A PERMANENT GENERATOR AT THE  
11 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH BUILDING, AS INITIATED BY  
12 B.T. 23-118; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE  
13 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
14 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
15 BEHALF OF THE CITY, MODIFICATION NUMBER 4 TO THE  
16 SUBGRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA,  
17 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE CITY OF  
18 JACKSONVILLE, CONTRACT NUMBER H0337; PROVIDING  
19 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION  
20 OF THE CITY'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;  
21 AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL  
22 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE  
23 2022-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT  
24 ENTITLED "DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH GENERATOR  
25 REPLACEMENT"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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27 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

28 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
29 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
30 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
31 listed in subsection (b):

7 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

8 The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency  
9 Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation  
10 Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of  
11 Emergency Management for the purchase and installation of  
12 a permanent generator at the Department of Health Building.

13 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
14 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation of  
15 a permanent generator at the Department of Health Building located  
16 at 515 West 6<sup>th</sup> Street, within Council District 7. The purchase and  
17 installation of a permanent generator will reduce and/or mitigate the  
18 damage that might occur as the result of severe weather or other  
19 hazards. The City match requirements have been met.

20 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
21 approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation  
22 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on  
23 behalf of the City, the Modification to Subgrant Agreement, Contract  
24 Number H0337, Modification Number Four, between the City of  
25 Jacksonville and the Florida Division of Emergency Management,  
26 substantially in the form placed **On File** with the Legislative Services  
27 Division.

28 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Public Buildings Division of the  
29 Department of Public Works shall oversee the project described herein.

30 **Section 5. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2022-505-E, being the  
31 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and

1 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to add  
2 additional funding for the project entitled "Department of Health  
3 Generator Replacement." The project is more fully described in the  
4 Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, and  
5 incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the  
6 deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget  
7 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the  
8 community because such deferral will result in the City's loss of  
9 needed grant dollars. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,  
10 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-  
11 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the  
12 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall  
13 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other  
14 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by  
15 Ordinance 2022-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

16 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
17 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
18 without the Mayor's signature.
