AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$411,625.25 GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, FUNDED THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM AND APPROVED BY THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A PERMANENT GENERATOR AT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH BUILDING, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-118; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, MODIFICATION NUMBER 4 TO THE SUBGRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, CONTRACT NUMBER H0337; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION OF THE CITY'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY 2022-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT "DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH ENTITLED REPLACEMENT"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management for the purchase and installation of a permanent generator at the Department of Health Building.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation of a permanent generator at the Department of Health Building located at 515 West 6th Street, within Council District 7. The purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe weather or other hazards. The City match requirements have been met.

Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Modification to Subgrant Agreement, Contract Number H0337, Modification Number Four, between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida Division of Emergency Management, substantially in the form placed On File with the Legislative Services Division.

Section 4. Oversight. The Public Buildings Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 5. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2022-505-E, being the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and

certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to add additional funding for the project entitled "Department of Health Generator Replacement." The project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in the City's loss of needed grant dollars. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
