6 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING A CONTINUATION GRANT;
7 APPROPRIATING \$270,000.00 (\$202,500.00 FROM
8 THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY - PORT
9 SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM AND A LOCAL MATCH OF
10 \$67,500.00 FROM THE CITY'S RESERVES) TO
11 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CBRNE PORT AND
12 MARITIME VESSEL SUPPORT SYSTEM AND THE PORT
13 STATIONARY DETECTION SYSTEM, AS INITIATED BY
14 B.T. 20-014; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE
15 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
16 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON
17 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE GRANT AWARD PACKAGE
18 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE U. S.
19 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY; PROVIDING FOR
20 OVERSIGHT BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE EMERGENCY
21 PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
22 DATE.

24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
26 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
27 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
28 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

4 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

5 The funding above comprises a grant of \$202,500.00 from
6 the Department of Homeland Security/Port Security Grant
7 Program and a City match of \$67,500.00 from Reserves to
8 provide funding for the CBRNE Port and Maritime Vessel
9 Support System and the Port Stationary Detection System.

10 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
11 Section 1 is to provide funding for the cost of the CBRNE Port and
12 Maritime Vessel Support System. The CBRNE support system includes
13 vessels that can transport up to six firefighters during shipboard
14 firefighting activities and hazardous material incidents, or marine
15 personnel to support marine incidents or natural disasters for
16 maritime missions that require the use of smaller work vessels and
17 equipment to initiate and maintain response and recovery operations
18 in and around port waterways. This grant will also fund the cost of
19 a Port Stationary Drone Detection System. The Port Stationary Drone
20 Detection System will provide monitoring and detection of the new
21 and emerging threat of UAVs for the entire Jacksonville Port area.
22 This investment directly addresses the National Port Security
23 priority of Regional Coordination and institutionalizes the
24 Regional Security Strategy Integration. This grant is a necessity
25 for the City of Jacksonville and citizens within Duval County and
26 the Northeast Florida Region. The period of performance is for
27 three years with all maintenance of this agreement being overseen
28 by the Director of the Emergency Preparedness Division. There will
29 be continuing maintenance costs once the grant expires.

30 **Section 3. Approving and authorizing execution.** There
31 is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the

1 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver,
2 for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Award Package between the
3 City of Jacksonville and the U. S. Department of Homeland Security,
4 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
5 reference. The grant period is from September 1, 2019, through
6 August 31, 2022.

7 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
9 without the Mayor's signature.
