WHEREAS, negotiations related to the Project are ongoing and may extend into fiscal year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Michael Huyghue & Associates, LLC (the "Agreement") is currently set to expire on September 30, 2024, but it is anticipated that the need for the services of Consultant may continue into fiscal year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Council therefore desires to extend the term of the Agreement to September 30, 2025, and to carryover the funds set aside to procure the professional services of the Consultant, to fiscal year 2024-2025; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Amendment to Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, that certain First Amendment to the Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Michael Huyghue & Associates, LLC for Stadium Lease and Development Consulting Services in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, to extend the term of the Agreement to September 30, 2025, with all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remaining unchanged.

Section 2. Carryover. The funds appropriated pursuant to Ordinance 2023-386-E to procure the professional services of Consultant remaining at the end of fiscal year 2023-2024 shall not lapse but shall carryover to September 30, 2025.

Section 3. Oversight. The Office of General Counsel shall continue to have oversight of the Agreement described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
