RESOLUTION 2025-786

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CERTAIN UPDATES TO THE CONCURRENCY AND MOBILITY MANAGEMENT HANDBOOK FOR JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, AS REFERENCED IN CHAPTER 655 (CONCURRENCY AND MOBILITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM), ORDINANCE CODE, WHICH PROVIDES THE LOCAL STRUCTURE FOR ADMINISTERING CHAPTER 163, PART II, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND AS REQUIRED IN SECTION 655.122 (CONCURRENCY AND MOBILITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM HANDBOOK), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 655 (CONCURRENCY AND MOBILITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM), ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in September 2011, through Ordinance 2011-536-E, the City revised Chapter 655 (Concurrency and Mobility Management System), Ordinance Code, to add Mobility to the Concurrency Management System and directed that a Concurrency and Mobility Management System Handbook ("Handbook") be developed as the official document containing the current procedures, methodologies and criteria to be used by the City in implementing Chapter 655, Ordinance Code, and

WHEREAS, in April 2014, through Ordinance 2014-183-E, the City amended Section 655.122 (Concurrency and Mobility Management System Handbook), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 655 (Concurrency and Mobility Management System) Ordinance Code to provide for updates to the Handbook and the establishment of a Technical Advisory Committee ("TAC") to be appointed by the President of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, in July 2016, through Resolution 2016-491-E, the Handbook was revised to include updates to website addresses, personnel and reference to and inclusion of a revised Mobility Fee Contract (For Administrative Approval); and

WHEREAS, based upon the meeting of the TAC on April 16, 2025, the draft Concurrency and Mobility Management System Handbook for Jacksonville, Florida dated April 30, 2025, was revised to include updates to certain definitions for consistency with Chapter 655, Ordinance Code, restructuring of the Handbook for clarity, accuracy and alignment with Chapter 655 outlining the mobility fee calculation and establishing the effective date for the mobility fee, and the inclusion of flowcharts for concurrency and mobility fee processes; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Handbook for Jacksonville, Florida updated. Those certain changes to the Concurrency and Mobility Management System Handbook for Jacksonville, Florida ("Handbook"), now dated April 30, 2025, is On File with the Legislative Services Division. The changes include updating the definitions for consistency with Chapter 655 (Concurrency and Mobility Management System Handbook), Ordinance Code, outline the procedures for obtaining a Mobility Fee Certificate, calculating fees based on the amount of vehicle miles traveled, and applying credits or exemptions, and the inclusion of flowcharts for concurrency and mobility fee processes.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
