5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$110,196.28 FOR FINAL
6 DESIGN ENGINEERING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS
7 SERVICES FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF BRIDGE NUMBER
8 724039 ON 5TH STREET OVER SIX MILE CREEK (THE
9 "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 21-050; PURPOSE
10 OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2021-2025 FIVE-
11 YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY
12 ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE
13 PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE
14 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, ENGINEERING AND
15 CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION; PROVIDING AN
16 EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The appropriation above represents a transfer of funds from

1 the Authorized Capital Projects Fund - Countywide
2 Intersection Improvements, Brge-Bridges account to the 5th
3 Street Bridge Replacement project account in the amount of
4 \$110,196.28 to pay for final design engineering plans and
5 specifications services for the Project.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
7 Section 1 is to pay for final design engineering plans and
8 specifications services for the replacement of a two-lane concrete
9 bridge (Bridge Number 724039) located on 5th Street between Ellis Road
10 and Edgewood Avenue North near Six Mile Creek (the "5th Street
11 Bridge"). The Florida Department of Transportation evaluated the 5th
12 Street Bridge and determined that it is load rated and structurally
13 deficient and requires replacement. The final design services will
14 also include acquisition of necessary permits, preparation of
15 construction plans and bid documents, and final design phase and
16 technical/constructionability reviews.

17 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
18 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
19 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
20 hereby amended to provide funding for the Project, as more fully
21 described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as
22 Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as **Revised Exhibit 2**, Revised CIP, April
23 5, 2021 - NCSPHS and incorporated herein by this reference. The City
24 Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until
25 the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best
26 interests of the community because such deferral would result in the
27 unnecessary delay of critical transportation infrastructure repairs
28 and upgrades to the 5th Street Bridge. Adequately maintaining the
29 City's bridge structures is a critical component of ensuring that its
30 infrastructure is safe and reliable for the citizens of Jacksonville.

1 The Project will correct structural deficiencies and bring the 5th
2 Street Bridge into compliance with the current design standards.

3 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
4 this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
5 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
6 amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute
7 an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the
8 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E
9 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

10 **Section 4. Oversight Department.** The Department of Public
11 Works, Engineering and Construction Management Division, shall
12 provide oversight for the Project.

13 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
15 without the Mayor's signature.
