9 ALLOCATIONS, TO FORGIVABLE LOANS TO COMPLETE  
10 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG-DR)  
11 COSTS OF NECESSARY AND PENDING HOME REPAIRS  
12 ATTRIBUTABLE TO DAMAGE CAUSED BY HURRICANE  
13 MATTHEW, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-112; PURPOSE OF  
14 APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS  
15 INTO SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS; PROVIDING AN  
16 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
22 listed in subsection (b):

30 The funding above represents a transfer of administrative  
31 expenses in the amount of \$234,672.91 from Salaries,

1 Benefits, Internal Service Allocations, and other  
2 administrative related budget line items to Forgivable  
3 Loans to complete Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-  
4 DR) costs of necessary home repairs arising from damage  
5 caused by Hurricane Matthew.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
7 Section 1 is to provide funding to cover the various line items  
8 outlined in B.T. 23-112 to complete Community Development Block Grant  
9 (CDBG-DR) costs of necessary home repairs arising from damage caused  
10 by Hurricane Matthew. The foregoing administrative expenses to be  
11 transferred are no longer required due to project close-out.

12 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds being transferred in this  
13 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to the subsequent fiscal  
14 year.

15 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
17 without the Mayor's signature.
