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4 **ORDINANCE 2022-689-E**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$4,294.00 FROM A  
6 DESIGNATED SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY TO  
7 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR FIRST COAST COMMUNITY  
8 DEVELOPMENT, INC. TO PROVIDE MEALS AND HEALTH  
9 SERVICES TO VULNERABLE RESIDENTS; REQUESTING  
10 CARRYOVER; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE  
11 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE A GRANT  
12 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND  
13 FIRST COAST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, INC. TO  
14 EFFECTUATE THIS LEGISLATION; INVOKING THE  
15 EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS),  
16 PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126,  
17 *ORDINANCE CODE*; WAIVING SECTION 118.107  
18 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A  
19 COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), *ORDINANCE*  
20 *CODE*; WAIVING SECTION 118.201(F) (7) (RELEASE OF  
21 APPROPRIATIONS), *ORDINANCE CODE*; AUTHORIZING  
22 THE MAYOR AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO  
23 EXECUTE ANY OR ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO  
24 EFFECTUATE THIS LEGISLATION; DESIGNATING THE  
25 OFFICE OF GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE TO  
26 OVERSEE THE PROJECT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE  
27 EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
31 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

1 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
2 listed in subsection (b):

9 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - Transfer funding from the  
10 designated Council contingency to First Coast Community  
11 Development, Inc. to provide meals and health services to  
12 vulnerable residents.

13 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
14 Section 1 above is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville  
15 to First Coast Community Development, Inc. so that they can provide  
16 meals and health services to vulnerable residents.

17 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated by this  
18 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover through September 30,  
19 2023.

20 **Section 4. Authorizing the Mayor and the Corporation**  
21 **Secretary to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate**  
22 **this legislation.** The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation  
23 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a grant  
24 agreement between the City of Jacksonville and First Coast Community  
25 Development, Inc.

26 **Section 5. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**  
27 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of  
28 the services of First Coast Community Development, Inc. to provide  
29 for meals and health services for vulnerable residents. Pursuant to  
30 Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations),  
31 Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is

1 exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or  
2 services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within  
3 authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the  
4 exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126,  
5 *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

6 **Section 6. Waiver of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to**  
7 **receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part**  
8 **1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code.**

9 The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding  
10 through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General  
11 Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), *Ordinance Code*, are hereby  
12 waived to allow for a direct contract with First Coast Community  
13 Development, Inc. and the City of Jacksonville. The City finds that  
14 First Coast Community Development, Inc. is a justified direct contract  
15 because First Coast Community Development, Inc. is a nonprofit  
16 organization which provides free meals and limited health services  
17 to vulnerable residents.

18 **Section 7. Waiver of Section 118.201(f)(7) (Release of**  
19 **Appropriations), Ordinance Code.**

20 Section 118.201(f)(7) (Release of  
21 Appropriations), Chapter 118 (City Grants), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby  
22 waived as to the disbursement of funds based upon draws for services  
23 performed or reimbursements for work done. Waiver of Section  
24 118.201(f)(7), *Ordinance Code*, is requested to allow advance payments  
25 in excess of 10% to First Coast Community Development, Inc. Due to  
26 the nature and purpose of the funding, advance payment equal to 1/2  
27 of the appropriation (\$2,147) will be allowed to be paid for start-  
28 up costs with the remainder paid upon completion of the project,  
29 subject to the terms of the agreement, drafted pursuant to Section 4  
of this Ordinance.

30 **Section 8. Oversight Department.** The Office of Grants and  
31 Contract Compliance within the Department of Finance and

1 Administration shall oversee the project described herein.

2           **Section 9.           Requesting one cycle emergency passage pursuant**  
3 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** Once cycle emergency passage of this  
4 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that this  
5 funding is coming from a Council contingency account that will return  
6 to the General Fund if not appropriated by September 30, 2022.  
7 Emergency action is requested so that this bill can be taken up at  
8 the last meeting in September to secure the appropriation of these  
9 funds for this purpose. Carryover language is requested so that First  
10 Coast Community Development, Inc. has time to expend the funds  
11 appropriated.

12           **Section 10.           Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
14 without the Mayor's signature.
