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## ORDINANCE 2023-554-E

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE; TO OFFICIALLY DECLARE THAT "RACETRACK" ROAD EXTENDING FROM PHILIPS HIGHWAY IN DUVAL COUNTY TO THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOUNDARY LINE SHOULD BE DESIGNATED AS TWO SEPARATE WORDS AS "RACE TRACK" ROAD; PROVIDING A COMPLIANCE TIME PERIOD TO REQUIRE THAT ALL CITIZENS, PROPERTY OWNERS, AND BUSINESS OWNERS GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES UTILIZE THE CORRECT DESIGNATION AND SPELLING OF "RACETRACK" AS "RACE TRACK" ROAD ON ANY AND ALL OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS, RESIDENCE ADDRESSES, STREET SIGNS, HIGHWAY MARKERS AND ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2024; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

"Racetrack Road" extending from Philips Highway in WHEREAS, Duval County to the St. Johns County Boundary Line has for many years been officially recognized by the City of Jacksonville as one word for purposes of street naming and addressing data. A map of "Race Track Road" is attached hereto as Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS, "Racetrack" Road extends into neighboring Saint Johns County; and

WHEREAS, a representative for the Saint Johns County Sheriff's Office confirmed that St. John's County's addressing data systems officially recognizes "Race Track" Road as two separate words; and

WHEREAS, mapping applications such as Google Maps recognizes
"Race Track" Road as two separate words; and

WHEREAS, the majority of City of Jacksonville street signs include "Race Track" Road as two separate words; and

WHEREAS, the discrepancy between "Racetrack" and "Race Track" has created confusion, and caused addressing data systems to perform incorrectly; and

WHEREAS, the Council seeks to officially recognize and declare that "Racetrack" Road extending from Philips Highway in Duval County to the St. Johns County Boundary Line should be designated as "Race Track" Road; and

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2023, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee voted to adopt the Staff recommendation for approval to officially recognize and declare that "Racetrack" Road extending from Philips Highway in Duval County to the St. Johns County Boundary Line should be designated and spelled as "Race Track" Road. A copy of the 911 Committee PowerPoint presentation, and the excerpt minutes of the July 5, 2023 public meeting of the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee are attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Minutes, September 19, 2023 - TEU"; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it appropriate to officially recognize and declare that "Racetrack Road" extending from Philips Highway in Duval County to the St. Johns County Boundary Line should be designated and spelled as "Race Track Road"; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
