Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Caleena M. Shirley to the Jacksonville Housing Authority, replacing Cynthia Funkhouser, for a first full term to expire on September 16, 2026.

Background Information: The Jacksonville Housing Authority is established pursuant to Chapter 51A, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to within its area of operation, prepare, carry out, acquire, lease, and operate housing projects; and provide for the construction, reconstruction, improvement, alteration, or repair of any housing project or any part thereof.

Section 51A.103, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the seven members of the board shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation of the Council.

Ms. Shirley holds a bachelor's degree from Rollins College. She is the North Florida Regional Director of the Black Business Investment Fund and worked previously for the City as a property administrator. Ms. Shirley is the VP and Legislative Chair of the National Association of Black Women in Construction and VP of the Greater First Coast Chamber of Commerce, Innovation and Trade. Ms. Shirley resides in Duval County in council district 12.
