**ORDINANCE 2025-105-E**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$18,400.00 IN GRANT  
FUNDING FROM THE HETZEL FAMILY FUND FOR THE  
BATTERY BEHAVIOR PROGRAM FOR DUVAL COUNTY TEEN  
COURT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-047; PROVIDING  
FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE COURT ADMINISTRATION,  
DIRECTOR OF TEEN COURTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,  
within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated

The funding above represents an appropriation of grant  
funds from the Hetzel Family Fund for the Battery Behavior  
Program for Duval County Teen Court. The grant period  
commenced on January 1, 2025, and continues through  
December 31, 2025. No local match is required.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in

1 Section 1 is to utilize grant funding from the Hetzel Family Fund to  
2 facilitate a comprehensive, evidence-based treatment program and  
3 curriculum for Teen Court involved youth who have received civil  
4 citations for misdemeanor battery and domestic battery charges. A  
5 copy of the Hetzel Family Fund Grant Award Letter providing the terms  
6 and conditions for the grant is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and  
7 incorporated herein by this reference.

8 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Court Administration, Director  
9 of Teen Courts shall oversee administration of the grant and program  
10 described herein.

11 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
13 without the Mayor's signature.
