23-325	Amendment and rerefer	(ORD Adopting a Small-Scale Amendmnt to the FLUM 2045 Comp Plan at 0 Brandy Branch Rd, btwn U.S. Hwy 301 S & the Duval/Nassau Co Boundary Line from LDR to AGR): 1. Attaches a Revised Exhibit 1 (revised Legal Description dated September 30, 2024). 2. Attaches a Revised Exhibit 2 (Subject Property Map) to reflect the change in acreage from 39.31 to 33.95 acres and location of the area that is the subject of the FLUM Amendment.
