6 **ORDINANCE 2021-887-E**

7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$18,833.39 FROM THE
8 ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT FUND TO THE WINTON
9 DRIVE PARK ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT (THE
10 "PROJECT") TO PAY INCREASED CONSTRUCTION COSTS
11 TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT, AS INITIATED BY B.T.
12 22-029; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE
13 2022-2026 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN
14 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2021-505-E TO APPROPRIATE
15 FUNDING FROM THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT
16 FUND TO THE PROJECT FOR COMPLETION OF A PUBLIC
17 ART INSTALLATION AT THE CORNER OF WINTON DRIVE
18 AND HOWELL DRIVE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
22 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
23 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
24 listed in subsection (b):

31 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

1 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$18,833.39
2 from the Art in Public Places Project fund to the Winton
3 Drive Park Art in Public Places Project (the "Project") to
4 cover increased costs for completion of the Project.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
6 Section 1 is to appropriate funds to the Winton Drive Park Art in
7 Public Places Project. This appropriation is necessary to cover
8 increased construction costs for completion of the Project which will
9 be installed in the Winton Drive Triangle at the corner of Winton
10 Drive and Howell Drive.

11 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
12 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
13 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
14 hereby amended to appropriate funds from the Art in Public Places
15 Project fund to the Winton Drive Park Art in Public Places Project
16 for completion of the Project as more fully described in the Project
17 Information Sheets attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as
18 "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP, January 18, 2022 - NCSPHS" and
19 incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that
20 the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget
21 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the
22 community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion
23 of the Project.

24 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
25 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
26 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
27 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
28 an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the
29 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E
30 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

31 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
2 without the Mayor's signature.
