The nature of the emergency is that the 19 Supervisor of Elections Office has an immediate need for these funds 20 to ensure expeditious implementation of the security enhancements.

21 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 23 without the Mayor's signature.
