5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE  
6 AMOUNT OF \$75,000.00 FROM THE FLORIDA  
7 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP)  
8 FOR ITS PARTICIPATION IN A STUDY TO ESTABLISH  
9 VULNERABILITY OF INFRASTRUCTURE AND RESOURCES  
10 THAT PLAY A ROLE IN THE CITY'S OPERATIONS AND  
11 ALLOW FOR PROPER PLANNING, AS INITIATED BY  
12 B.T. 20-050; AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR  
13 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY  
14 ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR  
15 THE PROJECT ENTITLED "FLORIDA RESILIENT  
16 COASTLINE PROGRAM FRCP"; AUTHORIZING THE  
17 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
18 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
19 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE STANDARD GRANT  
20 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA  
21 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND  
22 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR CITY  
23 OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION  
24 MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
25 PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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27 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

28 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
29 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
30 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
31 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

7 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

8 The funding above comprises grant funds from the  
9 Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for  
10 its participation in a study to establish the  
11 vulnerability of infrastructure and resources that play a  
12 role in the City's operations and allow for proper  
13 planning.

14 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this legislation is  
15 to appropriate grant funds from FDEP for its participation in a  
16 study to identify critical City infrastructure and natural resource  
17 communities which may be susceptible to increased levels of  
18 precipitation and increasing changes in sea level or tidal surge  
19 and to provide resiliency information on the more severe storms,  
20 larger tidal events, and resulting impacts.

21 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the  
22 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and  
23 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to use grant  
24 funds for the project entitled "Florida Resilient Coastline Program  
25 FRCP." The project is more fully described in the Project  
26 Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated  
27 herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of  
28 this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP  
29 review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community  
30 because such deferral could result in the City's losing valuable  
31 grant dollars. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code,*

1 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-  
2 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the  
3 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall  
4 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other  
5 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by  
6 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

7 **Section 4. Approving and authorizing execution of FDEP**  
8 **Standard Grant Agreement.** The Mayor, or his designee, and  
9 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver,  
10 for and on behalf of the City, the Standard Grant Agreement between  
11 the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the  
12 City of Jacksonville, in substantially the same form placed **ON FILE**  
13 with the Office of Legislative Services.

14 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Engineering and Construction  
15 Management Division of the Department of Public Works will provide  
16 oversight.

17 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
18 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
19 without the Mayor's signature.
