5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE  
6 AMOUNT OF \$12,462,500.00 FROM THE FLORIDA  
7 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ITS  
8 PARTICIPATION IN THE PROJECT COSTS TO DEMOLISH  
9 A PORTION OF THE ELEVATED, CONCRETE HART  
10 BRIDGE EXPRESSWAY AT LIBERTY STREET BETWEEN  
11 GATOR BOWL BOULEVARD AND A. PHILIP RANDOLPH  
12 BOULEVARD AND TO CONSTRUCT AN AT-GRADE  
13 INTERSECTION AT GATOR BOWL BOULEVARD, AS  
14 INITIATED BY B.T. 19-113; AMENDING THE 2019-  
15 2023 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM  
16 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2018-505-E TO PROVIDE  
17 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "HART BRIDGE  
18 RAMP MODIFICATION"; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR  
19 HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO  
20 EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE  
21 CITY, THE LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT  
22 BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF  
23 TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE;  
24 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND  
25 THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND  
26 DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE  
27 ROADWAY TRANSFER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE  
28 OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND  
29 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY,  
30 FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE  
31 ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

1 DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;  
2 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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4 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

5 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,  
6 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
7 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
8 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

15 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

16 The funding above is a grant from the Florida Department  
17 of Transportation (FDOT) for its participation in the  
18 project cost to demolish a portion of the elevated,  
19 concrete Hart Bridge Expressway at Liberty Street between  
20 Gator Bowl Boulevard and A. Philip Randolph Boulevard and  
21 to construct an at-grade intersection at Gator Bowl  
22 Boulevard.

23 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
24 Section 1 is to fund the demolition of a portion of the elevated,  
25 concrete Hart Bridge Expressway at Liberty Street between Gator  
26 Bowl Boulevard and A. Philip Randolph Boulevard and the  
27 construction of an at-grade intersection at Gator Bowl Boulevard.  
28 The intersection is to include signalization, pedestrian and bike  
29 paths, installation of traffic calming improvements, and the  
30 construction of a ramp at A. Philip Randolph Boulevard.

31 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2018-505-E, being the

1 2019-2023 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and  
2 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide  
3 funding for the project entitled "Hart Bridge Ramp Modification."  
4 The project is more fully described in the Project Information  
5 Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this  
6 reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of  
7 the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be  
8 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such  
9 deferral could jeopardize the City's ability to be awarded the FDOT  
10 grant funds. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,  
11 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-  
12 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the  
13 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall  
14 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2018-505-E. In all other  
15 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by  
16 Ordinance 2018-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

17 **Section 4. Authorization to execute Local Agency Program**  
18 **Agreement.** The Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary  
19 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of  
20 the City, the Local Agency Program Agreement between the Florida  
21 Department of Transportation and the City of Jacksonville, in  
22 substantially the same form placed **on file** with the Office of  
23 Legislative Services.

24 **Section 5. Authorization to execute Roadway Transfer**  
25 **Agreement.** The Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary  
26 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of  
27 the City, the Roadway Transfer Agreement between the State of  
28 Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Jacksonville,  
29 Duval County, Florida, in substantially the same form placed **on**  
30 **file** with the Office of Legislative Services. The Roadway Transfer  
31 Agreement will allow the transfer by Map Transfer of certain right-

1 of-way to the City, after which the City will own, operate,  
2 maintain, and repair the transferred right-of-way.

3       **Section 6.       Oversight.**       The Engineering and Construction  
4 Management Division of the Department of Public Works will provide  
5 oversight.

6       **Section 7.       Effective Date.**       This ordinance shall become  
7 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
8 without the Mayor's signature.
