AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,425,000.00 GRANT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY ("DHS") / FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ("FEMA"), FUNDED THROUGH THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, WITH NO LOCAL MATCH, TO THE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE ("UASI") GRANT, AND TO FUND THREE NEW POSITIONS WITHIN THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS INITIATED BY B.T. PROGRAM, AS AUTHORIZING SAID POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 24-074; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AGREEMENT NO. R0928, FEDERAL AWARD IDENTIFICATION NO. EMW-2023-SS-00058-S01, BETWEEN DHS/FEMA AND THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS RESCUE DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, Section 1. within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is a 2023 fiscal year Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security / Federal Emergency Management Agency, with no local match.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to enhance regional capacity and preparedness of the City of Jacksonville Metropolitan Statistical Area, comprised of Duval, St. Johns, Nassau, Baker and Clay counties, in the event of a terrorist act. This funding will purchase equipment, provide training, planning and the conducting of exercises in the event of a terrorist incident. This appropriation will also fund three (3) full-time employee positions within the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department. The grant period begins on the date of execution through September 30, 2025.

Section 3. Authorization of Positions. There are hereby authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 21-074, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver Agreement No. R0928, Federal Award Identification No. EMW-2023-SS-00058-S01, between DHS/FEMA and the City (the "Agreement"), substantially in the form placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services. The Agreement does not require a City match.

Section 5. Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee

administration of the UASI grant.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
