Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 4 Section 1 is to re-allocate HOME Grant Program funds originally 5 appropriated by Ordinance 2020-258-E to provide funding for down 6 7 payment assistance and rehabilitation of affordable housing for rent or ownership by low- and moderate-income individuals and 8 9 families and to correct certain revenue and project information provided on BT21-003 as approved by Ordinance 2020-258-E. 10 This reallocation is necessary to adjust for the Governor's veto of 11 affordable housing funding in the State of Florida fiscal year 12 2020-2021 budget and will allow these programs to remain open for a 13 portion of the 2020-2021 fiscal year instead of remaining closed. 14 In addition, HUD has approved, via an administrative waiver, the 15 City's use of up to twenty-five percent (25%) of these funds to pay 16 for the City's administration of the HOME Grant Program. 17
