(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation from the designated Opioid Settlement Fund Contingency account to the Opioid Settlement Fund - Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organizations account to fund Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Settlement Proceeds Grants ("OSUD Grants").

Section 2. Purpose. The OSUD Grant appropriation shall be allocated to the Prevention (34%), Treatment (33%) and Recovery Support (33%) categories as outlined and approved in Ordinance 2024-251-E, shall be used solely for the purpose of the listed Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Settlement Proceeds Grant categories and may not be transferred or reallocated for any other utilization within the respective department. OSUD Grants are subject to the provisions of Chapter 84, Ordinance Code. The appropriation made herein shall be awarded as grants-in-aid to miscellaneous agencies and shall not require additional legislation for distribution of funds. Pursuant to Section 118.808, Ordinance Code, the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee shall forward a complete list of the OSUD Grants recipients and funding allocations to the Council Auditor's Office, the Office of the Mayor, the City Council, and the Director of the Finance Department.

Section 3. Oversight. The Manager of Opioid Abatement within the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department shall oversee the grants described herein.

Section 4. Waiving Conflicting Provision of Section 84.301,

Ordinance Code. The conflicting provision of Section 84.301 (Opioid

Settlement Proceeds Allocation for Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), Part 3 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grant Award Procedures), Chapter 84 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), Ordinance Code, requiring this appropriation to be included in the Mayor's annual budget is hereby waived. Waiver of Section 84.301, Ordinance Code, is necessary because the OSUD Grant lump sum appropriation for the 2024-2025 annual budget will be considered and acted upon by Council by this Ordinance 2024-510 and not in the annual budget Ordinance 2024-504.
