8 COMPLETION OF IRRIGATION INSTALLATION ON WATER
9 STREET MEDIANS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-039;
10 PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2022-2026
11 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY
12 ORDINANCE 2021-505-E TO REFLECT THIS TRANSFER OF
13 FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
14 DATE.
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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
20 listed in subsection (b):

28 The funding above represents a transfer of \$25,000 from
29 unused contingency for FIND grant matches to the Downtown
30 Landscape Enhancements project (the "Project") for
31 completion of irrigation installation on the Water Street

1 medians.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
3 Section 1 is to provide funding for the Project to cover the costs
4 to complete installation of irrigation on Water Street medians.

5 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
6 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
7 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
8 hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the
9 Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet
10 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
11 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment
12 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be
13 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such
14 deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

15 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
16 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
17 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
18 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
19 an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the
20 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E
21 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

22 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
24 without the Mayor's signature.
