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ORDINANCE 2024-885

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,000 FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING RESERVES TO THE SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO IMPERFECT PEOPLE CENTER, INC., FOR HEALTH AND AWARENESS WORKSHOPS THAT ADDRESS CRITICAL HEALTH ISSUES IN DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA AS ORIGINALLY APPROVED AND AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 2024-462-E; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH IMPERFECT PEOPLE CENTER, INC.; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH IMPERFECT PEOPLE CENTER, INC.; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND IMPERFECT PEOPLE CENTER, INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING

AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$5,000 from General Fund Operating Reserves to the Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account to provide funding to Imperfect People Center, Inc. ("IPC") for health and awareness workshops aimed at addressing critical health issues prevalent in Duval County, Florida (the "Program") as originally appropriated and authorized by Ordinance 2024-462-E.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to IPC for the Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The City funds appropriated herein for this Program were originally appropriated by Ordinance 2024-462-E and a direct contract with IPC was also authorized pursuant to that legislation. However, the funds were unable to be encumbered prior to the end of the 2023-2024 fiscal year and therefore fell to Operating Reserves. Therefore, this legislation is necessary to

appropriate City funds for the Program in the 2024-2025 fiscal year and to authorize the requisite direct contract with IPC.

Section 3. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of Imperfect People Center, Inc. for the Program as described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Part 1 (General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Imperfect People Center, Inc. This waiver is justified because IPC has been hosting health awareness workshops within the community for over a decade and is well versed in the needs of the target audience. The overall mission of IPC encompasses a comprehensive approach to education, prevention, and support services to empower residents with the knowledge and resources to make informed decisions about their health and wellbeing. The City funds appropriated herein will allow IPC to provide health and awareness workshops to reach additional residents in Duval County.

Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an agreement with Imperfect People Center, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$5,000, subject to the Scope of Services and Budget

more particularly described in **Exhibit 2** as previously authorized by Ordinance 2024-462-E.

Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction Section 7. Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage of this legislation upon introduction is requested. The nature of emergency is that the funds were previously appropriated for the Program but fell to fund balance at the end of the 2023-2024 fiscal year. The Council would like to make the previously authorized grant funds available to IPC as soon as possible for the Program.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
