Type of Action: Appropriation of funds; designation of an oversight department

Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$150,000 in grant funding from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, through its Fiscal Year 2023-2024 State Financial Assistance for Fentanyl Eradication (“S.A.F.E.”) in Florida Program to the PSBU Grants/Operation Three Crowns Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Project to combat illegal fentanyl activity. It designates the Jacksonville Sheriff’s Office as the oversight department for the project.

Background Information: The Florida Legislature established state funding in 2023 to conduct investigations to combat illegal fentanyl activity under the S.A.F.E. Program. This grant funding will cover overtime-related expenses to increase JSO’s resources in conducting fentanyl-related investigations.

Policy Impact Area: Public health/safety

Fiscal Impact: This bill appropriates a \$150,000 grant from FDLE to pay for overtime-related expenses for JSO officers conducting fentanyl-related investigations.
