WHEREAS, Ordinance 2019-56-E enacted February 26, 2019, created a new Chapter 84 (Opioid Abuse Mitigation), Ordinance Code, and established the Opioid Abuse Prevention Committee; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2023-350-E enacted June 27, 2023, repealed Chapter 84 (Opioid Abuse Mitigation), Ordinance Code, in its entirety, and created a new Chapter 84 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), Ordinance Code, which established the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder (OSUD) Grants Committee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 84.202(b), Ordinance Code, the City Council President shall annually appoint a City Council Member to serve as a liaison to the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee. This is a non-voting position and shall not be considered a member of the OSUD Grants Committee for Sunshine purposes; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Reappointment. The Council hereby confirms the reappointment of Council Member Ron Salem, to the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee, as a liaison, pursuant to Section 84.202(b), Ordinance Code, for a term concurrent with the term of the
