ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR AN DISCLAIMING AN OPENED AND IMPROVED PORTION OF THE NORTH ENTRANCE ROAD (ALUMNI WAY) RIGHT-OF-WAY, AS RECORDED IN OFFICIAL RECORDS BOOK 3035, PAGE 41, OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 3, REQUEST OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA BOARD OF TRUSTEES; SUBJECT TO RESERVATION UNTO JEA OF AN ALL UTILITIES, FACILITIES AND ACCESS EASEMENT OVER THE CLOSURE PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT AREA; CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An opened and improved portion of the North Entrance Road (Alumni Way) right-of-way, as recorded in Official Records Book 3035, Page 41, of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 3, a depiction and description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed at the request of the University of North Florida Board of Trustees (the "Applicant") with the approval of the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection, as agent for and on behalf of, the Board of the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida; provided however, there is reserved unto JEA an all utilities, facilities and access easement on, over, under, through and across the closure area for

ingress and egress and for all utilities and facilities, so as to provide JEA with continued access to repair and maintain its utilities and facilities in the area.

The Applicant has paid the closure with encroachment application fee of \$2,607.00 and this sum has been deposited into the City's General Fund. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-of-way and there were no objections to the Applicant's request.

Section 2. Purpose. The Applicant is the lessee under a sublease from the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida, the fee simple owner of the real property on which the closure area is located (R.E. No. 167458-0020), and has requested this closure to connect properties within this parcel together for university educational, athletic and auxiliary uses.

Section 3. Hold Harmless Covenant. The closure and abandonment by the City of its interests in the right-of-way is subject to Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the right-of-way shall not be recorded in the public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
