## ORDINANCE 2020-418

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 106.109 (CAPITAL FUNDING), IMPROVEMENT PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), 106 CHAPTER (BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ESTABLISH OF AT LEAST 33% OF THEBUDGET, IMPROVEMENT PLAN AS DEFINED ΙN 122.602(C), BE ALLOCATED FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN THE PRE-CONSOLIDATION CITY BOUNDARY; PROVIDING FOR PRE-CONSOLIDATION CITY BOUNDARY MAP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Section 106.109 (Capital Improvement Funding), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code), Ordinance Code. Section 106.109 (Capital Improvement Funding), Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## CHAPTER 106. BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING CODE

## PART 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

## Sec. 106.109. - Capital Improvement Funding.

(a) The City shall have a Capital Improvement Plan that is designed to be financially feasible and provides the funding source and amount of funding for the capital costs of each project, and the funding source and amount of funding for the anticipated post-construction operation costs of each project. The Capital Improvement Plan shall be filed and approved each

fiscal year concurrently with the annual budget. (b) The City Council establishes a target of at least 33% of the Capital Improvement Plan Budget as defined in 122.602(c), to be allocated for Capital Improvements in the Pre-consolidation City boundary. The Capital Improvement Plan Budget target shall be reported each year in a separate section in the Mayor's budget proposal to the City Council. Section 2. Pre-consolidation City Boundary defined. Pre-consolidation City boundary shall be as indicated in the map attached hereto as Exhibit 1. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become Section 3. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature. Form Approved: /s/ Margaret M.
