5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING AN \$11,750.00
6 REIMBURSABLE GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES
7 TENNIS ASSOCIATION (USTA) FLORIDA SECTION
8 FOUNDATION TO ASSIST WITH COSTS ASSOCIATED
9 WITH THE CLOSURE OF CITY TENNIS FACILTITIES
10 BECAUSE OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, AS INITIATED
11 BY B.T. 20-110; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE
12 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
13 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON
14 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE FACILITY RECOVERY
15 GRANT AWARD LETTERS FOR BOONE PARK TENNIS
16 FACILITY, CLANZEL T. BROWN TENNIS FACILITY,
17 SOUTHSIDE TENNIS FACILITY, AND FORT FAMILY
18 TENNIS FACILITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
19 THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES
20 DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
25 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
26 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

2 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

3 The appropriation above is a Facility Recovery Grant from
4 the United States Tennis Association (USTA) Florida
5 Section Foundation to assist with costs associated with
6 the closure of City tennis facilities because of the
7 COVID-19 pandemic.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
9 Section 1 is to provide funding for materials and equipment to
10 assist in the recovery of costs associated with the resumption of
11 operations at City tennis facilities. Due to the COVID-19 shutdown,
12 the City's tennis facilities experienced decreased revenues for
13 tennis programs and losses in court materials due to the clay
14 courts' sitting unused and unmaintained for several weeks. The
15 reimbursement grant funds have been approved to be used for
16 supplies to assist with facility reopening, such as tennis balls,
17 teaching equipment, cleaning and sanitizing equipment, no-touch
18 items, and other expenses related to the reopening. Funds have been
19 approved in the following amounts for each of the four City of
20 Jacksonville Tennis Centers: Southside Tennis Center - \$5,000.00;
21 Boone Park Tennis Center - \$2,500.00; Fort Family Park Tennis
22 Center - \$2,000.00; and, Clanzel T. Brown Tennis Center - \$2,250.
23 No local match is required. The funds must be spent by no later
24 than September 30, 2020.

25 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
26 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
27 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
28 the City, the Facility Recovery Grant Award Letters for each of the
29 four City tennis facilities. Copies of the Facility Recovery Grant
30 Award Letters are attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
31 herein by this reference.

1 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Parks, Recreation and
2 Community Services Department shall oversee the project described
3 herein.

4 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
