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4 **ORDINANCE 2019-512**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE
6 GENERAL FUND/GENERAL SERVICE DISTRICT TO THE
7 CLARA WHITE MISSION FEEDING PROGRAM; APPROVING
8 AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS BY THE
9 MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE AND CORPORATION
10 SECRETARY; AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF TECHNICAL
11 AMENDMENTS BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE
12 OED; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE
13 OFFICE OF GRANTS AND COMPLIANCE OF THE
14 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION;
15 INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION 126.107(G),
16 *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS
17 FROM YEAR TO YEAR UNTIL SUCH FUNDS ARE
18 EXPENDED OR LAPSE ACCORDING TO THE AGREEMENT;
19 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

21 **WHEREAS**, the Clara White Mission was founded by Dr. Eartha M.
22 M. White, whose compassion for humanity moved her to action. The
23 Mission has existed for more than 100 years, dedicated to serving
24 the needs of the less fortunate in our community, and after more
25 than a century of service, remains devoted to the humanitarian
26 goals pursued so selflessly by the founder; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the Clara White Mission offers more than meals for
28 the hungry and transitional housing for the homeless. They offer
29 hope and a way out of the misery of a life on the streets, and they
30 provide food and housing, and additionally they also offer
31 vocational programs to put people to work; now therefore

1 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
3 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
4 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
5 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

7 incorporated herein by this reference)

12 (c) Explanation of Appropriation: the appropriation
13 above is appropriating \$100,000 from General
14 Fund/General Service District to Clara White
15 Mission, Inc. to provide a grant for HVAC repairs
16 and improvements, and kitchen, food preparation and
17 distribution equipment improvements for the Feeding
18 Program.

19 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
20 Section 1 is to provide funding to Clara White Mission, Inc. for
21 HVAC repairs and improvements, kitchen, food preparation and
22 distribution equipment improvements for the Feeding Program.
23 Funding will disbursed to the Clara White Mission, Inc. on a
24 reimbursement basis.

25 **Section 3. Clara White Mission, Inc. (\$100,000)**
26 **authorizing Direct Contracting and invoking the exception to**
27 **126.107(g), Ordinance Code.**

28 **1. Approval and authorization to execute.** The Mayor, or his
29 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby
30 authorized to execute a grant agreement in accordance with
31 Chapter 118, Parts 1, 2, 4 and 5, *Ordinance Code*, with

1 Clara White Mission, Inc. to appropriate \$100,000 for the
2 2019-2020 fiscal year to be used for the Food Program for
3 HVAC repairs and improvements, and kitchen, food
4 preparation and distribution equipment improvements as
5 more fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto.

6 **2. Invoking the exception to Sec. 126.107(g), Ordinance Code.**

7 The City is hereby authorized to enter into a grant
8 agreement with Clara White Mission, Inc. to provide
9 funding to Clara White Mission for the Food Program.
10 Pursuant to Section 126.107(g), *Ordinance Code*, such
11 procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation.
12 With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions
13 of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force
14 and effect.

15 **3. Oversight Department.** The Office of Grants and Compliance
16 of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
17 oversee the project described herein.

18 **Section 4. Further Authorizations.** The Mayor, or his
19 designee, and the Corporation Secretary, are hereby authorized to
20 execute the Agreement and all other contracts and documents and
21 otherwise take all necessary action in connection therewith and
22 herewith. The Office of Grants and Compliance, as contract
23 administrator, is authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary
24 changes and amendments to the Agreement and other contracts and
25 documents, to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance, without
26 further Council action, provided such changes and amendments are
27 limited to amendments that are technical in nature, and further
28 provided that all such amendments shall be subject to appropriate
29 legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her
30 designee, and all other appropriate official action required by
31 law. "Technical" is herein defined as including, but not limited

1 to, changes in legal descriptions and surveys, descriptions of
2 infrastructure improvements and/or any road project, ingress and
3 egress, easements and rights of way, performance schedules
4 (provided that no performance schedule may be extended for more
5 than one year without Council approval) design standards, access
6 and site plan, which have no financial impact.

7 **Section 5. Carryover.** The funds appropriated hereby
8 shall not lapse but shall carryover as appropriated from year to
9 year until such funds are expended or lapse according to the terms
10 of the Economic Development Agreement.

11 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
13 without the Mayor's signature.
