**Bill Summary:** This bill appropriates \$1,342,200.40 pursuant to B.T. 26-063, consisting of a transfer of \$128,186.00 within the Countywide Traffic Calming Project and transfers of \$630,917.50 from the Countywide Roadway Sign Stripe and Signal Project and \$583,096.90 from the Countywide Intersection Improvements Project, to fund (1) \$565,112.67 to the Traffic Signal Rebuild – 21st Street East and Liberty Street North Project and (2) \$648,901.73 to the Traffic Signal Rebuild – 21st Street West and Boulevard Street Project (together, the "Projects"). The bill amends the 2026–2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) approved by Ordinance 2025-505-E to reflect the appropriation. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment.

**Background Information:** The funds will be used to replace signal equipment and improve pedestrian crossings at two named signal rebuild locations. Of the \$128,186.00 within the Countywide Traffic Calming Project, funds are transferred within that project rather than from it. The remaining \$1,214,014.40 is appropriated from the Countywide Roadway Sign Stripe and Signal Project and the Countywide Intersection Improvements Project. The City Council finds that deferring the CIP amendment until the next annual budget and CIP review would be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral would unnecessarily delay commencement and completion of the Projects.

**Policy Impact Area:** Public Works; Transportation; Capital Improvement Plan

**Fiscal Impact:** No additional appropriation required. The bill transfers \$1,342,200.40 among existing capital projects pursuant to B.T. 26-063 to fund two traffic signal rebuild projects at 21st Street East and Liberty Street North (\$565,112.67) and 21st Street West and Boulevard Street (\$648,901.73).

**Analyst:** Libby
