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7 **ORDINANCE 2020-70**

8 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$267,093.62 FROM  
9 TRAIL RIDGE LANDFILL MITIGATION FUNDS TO  
10 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR LIGHTS AT YELLOW WATER  
11 BALLFIELDS (\$108,342.17), BALDWIN BASEBALL  
12 ITEMS (\$10,000), MAXVILLE DRAINAGE  
13 (\$143,751.45) AND CONTINGENCY (\$5,000);  
14 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS,  
15 RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT,  
16 DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS UPON INVOICES, AND  
17 ACCOUNTING/REVERTER OF ANY UNSPENT FUNDS;  
18 INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF 126.107(G)  
19 (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS),  
20 CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), *ORDINANCE*  
21 *CODE*, TO PROCURE THE GOODS AND SERVICES OF B&G  
22 ELECTRICAL, J.B. COXWELL CONTRACTING, INC. AND  
23 BURBANK SPORTS NET; AMENDING THE 2020-2024  
24 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED  
25 BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR  
26 THE PROJECT ENTITLED "MAXVILLE PARK  
27 IMPROVEMENTS - DRAINAGE"; PROVIDING AN  
28 EFFECTIVE DATE.

30 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

31 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,

1 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
2 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
3 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

4 (The account information is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, and  
5 incorporated herein by this reference)

10 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is  
11 appropriating \$267,093.62 from Trail Ridge Landfill  
12 Mitigation funds for lights at Yellow Water Ballfields  
13 (\$108,342.17), a Baldwin Baseball items (\$10,000),  
14 Maxville Drainage (\$143,751.45), and for contingency  
15 (\$5,000).

16 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this appropriation is  
17 to provide funding from the Trail Ridge Landfill Mitigation Fund to  
18 provide funding for lights at Yellow Water Ballfields (located at  
19 500 Yellow Water Road, Baldwin, Florida 32234) for \$108,342.17, for  
20 Baldwin Baseball items (located at 291 Mill Street West, Baldwin,  
21 Florida 32234) for \$10,000.00, for Maxville Drainage (located at  
22 1806 Pennsylvania Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32234)  
23 \$143,751.45, and \$5,000.00 for contingency, for a total cost of  
24 \$267,093.62, as identified in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto.

25 **Section 3. Oversight/Disbursement of Funds may exceed**  
26 **Projected Costs/Accounting/Reverter.** The Mayor is requested to  
27 appoint the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department  
28 (the "Department") to oversee the purchase and installation of the  
29 improvements. The Department may allocate funding for any of the  
30 projects listed in **Exhibit 2** in an amount more or less than the  
31 projected costs shown in **Exhibit 2** so long as the total costs of

1 the project do not exceed the appropriated amount of \$267,093.62.  
2 The Accounting Division is hereby authorized to transfer funds from  
3 one project to another to effectuate this so long as the total  
4 costs appropriated herein have not been exceeded. Any funds not  
5 utilized for the purposes set forth in this ordinance shall be  
6 returned to the fund of origin by September 30, 2020.

7 **Section 4. Invoking the exception to Sec. 126.107(g),**  
8 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to procure the goods  
9 and services of B&G Electrical, J.B. Coxwell Contracting, Inc. and  
10 Burbank Sports Net, as described in **Exhibit 2**. Funds shall be  
11 disbursed only after the final billing invoices have been delivered  
12 to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department.  
13 Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General  
14 Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such  
15 procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the  
16 supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically  
17 prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the  
18 same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of  
19 Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

20 **Section 5. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being  
21 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City  
22 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to  
23 provide funding for the project entitled "Maxville Park  
24 Improvements - Drainage." The project is more fully described in  
25 the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and  
26 incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the  
27 deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget  
28 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the  
29 community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay in  
30 drainage improvements to Maxville Park. Pursuant to Section  
31 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this ordinance requires

1 the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present  
2 at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this  
3 section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance  
4 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital  
5 Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue  
6 in full force and effect.

7 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
9 without the Mayor's signature.
