Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$152,362 funds from the General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency Account to the Atlantic Beach Lifeguard—Beach Capital Outlay – Other Construction Costs Account. The funding will be used for the construction and remodels of the Atlantic Beach Lifeguard Station at 1 Ahern Street in Atlantic Beach.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide additional financial assistance to complete the lifeguard station project. The City of Jacksonville previously allocated funds for this project through Ordinance 2021-504-E, which also authorized an agreement with the City of Atlantic Beach to outline project implementation. However, costs have exceeded the initial estimate, and the City of Atlantic Beach has requested additional funding. This legislation also authorizes an amendment to the agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the City of Atlantic Beach, increasing the total project funding and extending the agreement’s term until September 30, 2026. Additionally, it provides for the carryover of appropriated funds along with any remaining unexpended fund from Ordinance 2021-504-E to Fiscal Year 205-206. The Public Works Department will oversee the project management and implementation.
