Contract/Grant Term: January 1, 2026 – March 31, 2027

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Works Progress Administration Era Fire Tower (the "Tower") is located at 625 Stockton Street, adjacent to old JFRD Fire Station #8. The Tower is highly visible from the I-10 East entrance into the core of downtown Jacksonville and is recognized by many commuters. It was the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department's historic training facility. The Tower was constructed as a WPA project in 1930s and served as the primary training grounds for the fire service for 60 plus years. The Tower was closed in 1991 when a new training facility came on line and is currently owned by the Jacksonville Association of Fire Fighters. It is currently still utilized as a supplemental training facility for the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department ("JFRD").

PROGRAM SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES:

The Project will entail exterior and interior restoration of the Tower including replacement/repair of wooden windows and doors, repair of the existing fire escape, and exterior repair of masonry issues.

If Recipient expends more than \$25,000 in City funding for the Project, Recipient shall be required to execute a restrictive covenant agreement with the City of Jacksonville to ensure dedicated use of the Tower for public purposes, including but not limited to, continued use of the Tower by JFRD and other fire service providers as a training facility, for a period of not less than ten years. The restrictive covenant agreement shall identify the total amount of City funds expended.

PROGRAM COSTS/PAYMENT TERMS:

The City's maximum contribution for the Project shall be the lesser of \$245,220 or actual verified Project costs. The City funds shall be disbursed on a work performed and invoiced basis. Recipient shall provide support to the City for amounts invoiced for the Project, including but not limited to, contractor invoices. Recipient may invoice the City no more than once monthly. In addition, Recipient shall be required to provide support (paid invoice, bank/check support, etc.) to the City reflecting that all previous invoices have been satisfied, before further disbursement is made by the City.

The Project shall be completed on or before March 31, 2027 ("Performance Schedule"). Any costs incurred after March 31, 2027, shall be the responsibility of JAFF. The City shall have no obligation to pay for Project costs incurred outside of the Grant Term. Upon mutual agreement of JAFF and the City, the Gant Term and Performance Schedule may be extended by up to 6 months without further City Council action, subject to approval by the Office of General Counsel.

JAFF shall be responsible for any overage costs to complete the Project. In addition, JAFF shall be responsible for all upkeep and maintenance of the Tower, including any costs associated with said upkeep and maintenance.

PROGRAM IMPACT & REPORTING:

This Project will restore one of the two remaining WPA fire training towers in the United States, using contractors chosen for restoration of the Tower to its historic, original condition. JAFF relishes its history and has continued to maintain the Tower's original features, as well as adding lighting to showcase the structure at night. The JFRD continues to utilize the Tower in a limited capacity for training as its central geographic location within Duval County lessens the travel time and fuel required for fire service training.

ADDITIONAL GRANT REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS:

Recipient's expenditure of City funds for the Project shall be subject to the terms and conditions of any contract entered into between the City and Recipient. Recipient shall use the City funds for the Project in accordance with the City Council approved Term Sheet and Project budget. The City's Grant Administrator may amend this Term Sheet or the approved Project budget consistent with the Project's needs, provided that any substantial change to this Term Sheet or a budget change not within 10% of the attached Project budget line-items will require City Council approval.
