7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$275,000.00 FROM THE
8 SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE "FUND")
9 FOR DONATIONS TO NORTH FLORIDA COUNCIL, INC.,
10 BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA (\$10,000.00), THE PARENT
11 HELP CENTER, INC. (\$20,000.00), FIRST COAST
12 CRIME STOPPERS, INC. (\$23,000.00), FLORIDA CRIME
13 PREVENTION ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED
14 (\$1,000.00), AND THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
15 MEMORIAL AND MUSEUM (\$1,000.00), IN ACCORDANCE
16 WITH SECTION 932.7055(5), FLORIDA STATUTES, TO
17 SUPPORT DRUG TREATMENT, DRUG ABUSE EDUCATION,
18 DRUG PREVENTION, CRIME PREVENTION, SAFE
19 NEIGHBORHOODS, AND SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER
20 PROGRAM(S), TRANSFERRING \$12,500.00 FROM THE
21 FUND TO THE TEEN DRIVER SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR
22 THE TEEN DRIVER CHALLENGE PROGRAM, IN ACCORDANCE
23 WITH SECTION 111.365, *ORDINANCE CODE*,
24 TRANSFERRING \$7,500.00 FROM THE FUND TO THE
25 POLICE EXPLORERS TRUST FUND FOR THE JACKSONVILLE
26 SHERIFF'S POLICE EXPLORER POST, AND \$200,000.00
27 TO PROCURE AND INSTALL SECURITY FENCING AT
28 VARIOUS JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE
29 FACILITIES; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; APPROVING
30 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND

1 THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER
2 ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, MISCELLANEOUS
3 APPROPRIATIONS AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF
4 JACKSONVILLE AND NORTH FLORIDA COUNCIL, INC.,
5 BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA, THE PARENT HELP CENTER,
6 INC., AND FIRST COAST CRIME STOPPERS, INC.;
7 PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE
8 SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

11 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
12 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
13 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
14 listed in subsection (b):

15 (B.T. 21-103 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by
16 this reference)

21 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

22 The funding above represents an appropriation of
23 \$275,000.00 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund
24 for donations to various organizations as set forth herein
25 to support drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug
26 prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or
27 school resource officers programs administered by various
28 agencies in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida
29 Statutes. In addition, the funding above includes a
30 transfer of \$12,500.00 from the Fund to the Teen Driver
31 Special Revenue Fund for the Teen Driver Challenge Program

1 in accordance with Section 111.365, *Ordinance Code*, and a
2 transfer of \$7,500.00 from the Fund to the Police Explorers
3 Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Police
4 Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340,
5 *Ordinance Code*. This funding also includes \$200,000.00 to
6 purchase and install security fencing at various
7 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office facilities.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
9 Section 1 is to provide donations to the following organizations, in
10 the stated amounts: North Florida Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America
11 (\$10,000.00), The Parent Help Center, Inc. (\$20,000.00), First Coast
12 Crime Stoppers, Inc. (\$23,000.00), Florida Crime Prevention
13 Association Incorporated (\$1,000.00), and the National Law
14 Enforcement Memorial and Museum (\$1,000.00). This allocation
15 supports drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime
16 prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or school resource officer
17 programs for the citizens of the City of Jacksonville, Duval County,
18 Florida. A Certification from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that
19 the subject appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund
20 complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, is attached hereto
21 as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

22 In addition to the above, this appropriation includes a transfer
23 of \$12,500.00 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund
24 for the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section
25 111.365, *Ordinance Code*, as well as a transfer of \$7,500.00 from the
26 Fund to the Police Explorers Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's
27 Office Police Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340,
28 *Ordinance Code*, and \$200,000.00 for the purchase and installation of
29 security fencing for various Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
30 facilities.

31 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby

1 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
2 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
3 the City, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City
4 of Jacksonville and North Florida Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of
5 America, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City
6 of Jacksonville and The Parent Help Center, Inc., and the
7 Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of
8 Jacksonville and First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. in substantially
9 the same forms as have been placed **On File** with the Office of
10 Legislative Services. The Miscellaneous Appropriation Agreements on
11 file authorize advance lump sum payments.

12 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
13 shall oversee the projects described herein.

14 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
16 without the Mayor's signature.
