AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUND BALANCE FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FUND (THE "FUND") IN THE AMOUNT OF \$274,000.00 FOR INSTALLATION OF A NUTRIENT SEPARATING BAFFLE BOX PILOT PROJECT BY CENTRAL PIPE REHAB LLC, TO TREAT STORMWATER PRIOR TO ITS DISCHARGE INTO THE ST. JOHNS RIVER (THE "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-073; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2024; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND CENTRAL PIPE REHAB LLC FOR THE PROJECT; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO DIRECT CONTRACT WITH CENTRAL PIPE REHAB LLC FOR THE PROJECT; WAIVING SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE OF CITY FUNDS; PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE CITY TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR ADVANCE PAYMENT BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION; REQUIRING REPORTS ON MONITORING ACTIVITIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The appropriation above is fund balance from the Environmental Protection Trust Fund (the "Fund") to procure the professional services of Central Pipe Rehab LLC for the installation of a pilot project for stormwater treatment as described herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for installation of baffle boxes to treat stormwater prior to its direct discharge to the St. Johns River (the "Project"). This Project arises from a directive from the State of Florida to various municipalities throughout the state requesting they undertake measures to reduce nutrient and pollutant loading into impaired water bodies. The City's existing infrastructure allows pollutants to be carried miles away from their origin, resulting in unnatural pollutant concentrations. The baffle boxes to be installed as part of the Project are intended to prevent solid pollutants from moving through waterways to these collection points. The Project also entails monitoring and testing to determine and confirm that nutrient and other pollutant removal is occurring.

During its meeting on March 21, 2022, the Jacksonville Environmental Protection Board (the "Board") approved this

expenditure, as reflected in the Monthly Meeting Summary attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover through September 30, 2024.

Section 4. Agreement Approved and Execution Authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Central Pipe Rehab LLC for Services Relating to the NSBB Project, in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include any respective extensions or amendments thereto as necessary and appropriate to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance; provided, however, no modifications to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or the liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of Central Pipe Rehab LLC as stated in the Agreement.

Section 5. Invoking the Exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of Central Pipe Rehab LLC to conduct the Project. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Waiver of Section 110.112, Ordinance Code.

Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1

(The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Ordinance Code, is

3	Section 7. Oversight. The Neighborhoods Department,
4	Environmental Quality Division, shall provide oversight of the
5	Agreement and Project described herein.
6	Section 8. Monitoring Reports. Central Pipe Rehab LLC is
7	required to provide a six-month and final report on monitoring
8	activities to the Neighborhoods Department, Environmental Quality
9	Division.
10	Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
11	effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
12	without the Mayor's signature.
