5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$60,000.00 IN FUNDS  
6 FROM DEBT MANAGEMENT LOAN PROCEEDS TO PROVIDE  
7 FUNDING FOR THE DESIGN OF THE RENOVATION OF AN  
8 EXISTING BUILDING AT 4035 GRANT ROAD TO BECOME  
9 THE PINE FOREST SENIOR CENTER; AMENDING THE  
10 2021-2025 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM  
11 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO REDUCE  
12 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "SAN JOSE BLVD  
13 - NEW" AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT  
14 ENTITLED "PINE FOREST SENIOR CENTER"; PROVIDING  
15 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,  
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
21 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation**

29 The funds above are from Debt Management Fund Loan Proceeds  
30 for the design services for the renovation of an existing  
31 building for a new senior center at 4035 Grant Road.

1           **Section 2.           Purpose.**   The purpose of the appropriation in  
2 Section 1 is to provide funds for the design services for the  
3 renovation of an unoccupied existing health clinic at 4035 Grant Road  
4 to become the Pine Forest Senior Center.

5           **Section 3.           CIP Amendment.**   Ordinance 2020-505-E, being the  
6 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and  
7 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce the  
8 funding for the project entitled "San Jose Blvd - New" and provide  
9 funding for the project entitled "Pine Forest Senior Center." The  
10 projects are more fully described in the Project Information Sheet,  
11 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this  
12 reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of  
13 the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be  
14 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such  
15 deferral will result in the unnecessary delay of the design of the  
16 new senior center. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,  
17 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-  
18 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the  
19 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall  
20 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other  
21 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by  
22 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

23           **Section 4.           Effective Date.**   This ordinance shall become  
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
25 without the Mayor's signature.
