A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA FOR ITS EXCEPTIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN WOMEN'S ATHLETICS AND RECOGNIZING THE STUDENT-ATHLETES, COACHES, AND STAFF FOR THEIR DEDICATION TO EXCELLENCE BOTH ON THE FIELD AND IN THE CLASSROOM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 WHEREAS, the University of North Florida (UNF) has 13 demonstrated a steadfast commitment to the advancement of women's 14 sports, fostering a culture of achievement, integrity, and academic 15 excellence; and

WHEREAS, exemplifying the balance of academic and athletic excellence, UNF's women student-athletes have achieved a remarkable cumulative GPA of 3.58, including 90 percent of its student-athletes achieving at least a 3.0 GPA, and 42 earning a perfect 4.0; and

20 WHEREAS, the UNF Athletic Department won the Atlantic Sun 21 (ASUN)Conference's 2024-25 President's Academic Cup, and the ASUN 22 Conference's highest APR award was due to the academic success of its 23 student-athletes; and

WHEREAS, during the most recent athletic season, UNF women's teams secured 3 team championships and 4 individual championships, showcasing their competitive spirit and elite performance; and

WHEREAS, reflecting the depth of talent and leadership across programs, 42 women student-athletes were named All-Conference, 4 earned Player of the Year honors, and 2 were recognized as Scholar-Athletes of the Year; and

WHEREAS, setting new standards of excellence and inspiring

1 future generations, 3 women student-athletes received 8 All-American
2 selections, and 37 program records were broken; and

3 WHEREAS, softball standout, Allison Benning, earned many 4 honors for both her pitching and hitting abilities, she was named 5 ASUN Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Pitcher of the Year, and 6 Player of the Year; Ms. Benning was also named Mid-Major Player of 7 the Year to go along with her All-American honors; and

8 WHEREAS, Zara Siassi became UNF's first All-American in 9 Women's Soccer during the 2024 season, and was also named the ASUN 10 Conference Defensive Player of the Year and Academic All-American; 11 and

WHEREAS, Smilla Kolbe became UNF's first NCAA Indoor Track All-American when she finished 5th in the 800m at the National Championships, she was also named the ASUN Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Year and the ASUN Most Outstanding Track Performer of the Year; and

WHEREAS, these accomplishments bring pride to the City of Jacksonville and serve as a testament to the strength of collegiate athletics in our community; now therefore
