## ORDINANCE 2024-555-E

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE CITY-OWNED BUILDING LOCATED AT 515 JULIA STREET, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32202, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, PURSUANT TO SECTION 122.105 (PUBLIC BUILDINGS, PUBLIC FACILITIES AND PUBLIC PARKS NAMING AND RENAMING PROCEDURES), ORDINANCE CODE, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "GARY F. KEYS, SR. FIRE RESCUE HEADQUARTERS"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville owns the building located at 515 Julia Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202, in Council District 7 which serves as the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department ("JFRD") headquarters; and

WHEREAS, Gary F. Keys, Sr. served as Chief of the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department for 29 years beginning in 1960 and was an original member of the Rescue Division that was established in 1968; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure with the City of Jacksonville, Chief Keys served in a number of integral positions within JFRD including Chief of Operations and Chief of Fire Services; he also served as Jacksonville's Deputy Director of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, the culmination of Chief Keys' career came in 1988

30 31 when he was promoted to Fire Chief, the highest ranking position within the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his storied career with JFRD, Chief Keys served three terms as President of the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) Local 122 union and upon his retirement from JFRD he returned to the union to become its business agent; and

WHEREAS, although Chief Keys passed away on December 23, 2014, his legacy with JFRD and the City is still felt today by those who knew him personally and by those firefighters who have come behind him, despite never having the privilege to meet him; his impact is not only felt in the multiple tactics, procedures and policies he created for JFRD, but also in the standards he set for all union presidents who represent our firefighters; and

WHEREAS, it is for these reasons the Jacksonville City Council desires to recognize Gary F. Keys, Sr. by naming the building located at 515 Julia Street the "Gary F. Keys, Sr. Fire Rescue Headquarters" pursuant to Section 122.105, Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Section of the Community Planning Division of the Planning and Development Department has provided its report in accordance with Section 122.105(b), Ordinance Code, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and recommends approval of the proposed naming of the City-owned building located at 515 Julia Street as the "Gary F. Keys, Sr. Fire Rescue Headquarters"; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission did not provide an advisory recommendation to the Council within 45 days of the introduction of this Ordinance and as such this is deemed consent to the name proposal by the Historic Preservation Commission pursuant to Section 122.105(c), Ordinance Code; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The building located at 515 Julia Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202, is hereby named the "Gary F. Keys, Sr. 1
