The Planning Department respectfully requests approval to accept a \$50,000 grant award through the State of Florida, Department of State, Division of Historical Resources for the North Riverside Survey Update project. Although titled a small matching grant, the City of Jacksonville will not have to provide matching funds.

The grant award is between the City of Jacksonville and State of Florida, Department of State, Division of Historical Resources to conduct a partial update of the 2004 historic survey of North Riverside. The scope of work includes procuring professional historic preservation services, conducting archival research, conducting field surveys; completing a minimum of four hundred (400) new Florida Master Site File forms, and preparing a survey report. In order to perform these services, the City of Jacksonville will utilize the University of Florida as a consulting partner.

The Grantee has been awarded a Small Matching Grant by the Division, grant number 26.h.sm.200.127 for the Project "North Riverside (Lackawanna and Mixontown Neighborhoods) Survey Update," in the amount of \$50,000 ("Grant Award Amount"). The Division enters into this Agreement pursuant to Line Item 2918, contained in the 2026 General Appropriations Act, SB2500, Laws of Florida. The Division has the authority to administer this grant in accordance with Section 267.0617, Florida Statutes. Grant funds will be used to conduct the North Riverside (Lackawanna and Mixontown Neighborhoods) Survey Update, in Jacksonville. The scope of work will include: procuring professional historic preservation services, conducting archival research, conducting field surveys; completing a minimum of four hundred (400) new Florida Master Site File forms, and preparing a survey report conforming to Chapter 1A-46, Florida Administrative Code (FAC).
