This funding is to provide for the repayment by the City of funds received from the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant Agreement No. 12-00182. The Agreement was entered into in January 1981 for the development of the St. Johns Esplanade project, but ultimately the Agreement was made applicable to Metropolitan Park. At the time, the City received the grant contribution from the State DEP with the stipulation that the property be used for recreational purposes.

The City is preparing Metropolitan Park and adjacent property for redevelopment. Section 8 of the Grant Agreement allows the City to return the funds to the State in lieu of replacing Metropolitan Park with similar property if for any reason the City should covert Metropolitan Park to some use other than recreational purposes.

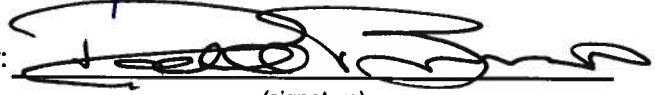
