4 **ORDINANCE 2024-698**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$12,500 FROM THE  
6 COUNCIL PRESIDENT’S DESIGNATED CONTINGENCY TO  
7 THE OFFICE OF SPORTS AND ENTERTAINMENT - SPECIAL  
8 EVENTS FOOD ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS  
9 FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC  
10 BEVERAGES AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING AN  
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
15 within the City’s budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
16 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
17 listed in subsection (b):

25 The funding above is an appropriation of \$12,500 from the  
26 Council President’s Designated Contingency to the Office  
27 of Sports and Entertainment - Special Events Food account  
28 to provide additional funds for the purchase of food and  
29 non-alcoholic beverages.

30 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
31 Section 1 is to provide additional funds for the purchase of food and

1 non-alcoholic beverages for Sports and Entertainment outreach,  
2 development and networking occasions in fiscal year 2023-2024. Food  
3 and beverage are traditionally procured through several different  
4 providers including, but not limited to, all City Sports and  
5 Entertainment Venue Suite Services, grocers and catering/restaurant  
6 food services providers. The Council authorizes this appropriation  
7 recognizing the City's Venue Suites and other locations where the  
8 Office of Sports and Entertainment may host business development  
9 meetings are used to showcase the City and its venues to entice and  
10 attract businesses, events and other opportunities to Jacksonville.

11 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
13 without the Mayor's signature.
