Specifically, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD) submitted a request for an honorary street designation on Manor Drive, extending from Timuquana Road to Old Timuquana Road, to honor "Captain Thomas M. Barber", a fallen fire and rescue officer who died while in the line of duty.

An honorary street designation allows the City to recognize the achievements of prominent individuals in Jacksonville without changing the official street name of a roadway.
