5 **ORDINANCE 2025-164-E**

6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE  
7 HOMELESSNESS INITIATIVES SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO  
8 THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING - SALARIES OVERTIME  
9 ACCOUNT WITHIN THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE  
10 ("JSO") TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO JSO FOR OVERTIME  
11 SALARIES RELATED TO THE PROVISION OF SECURITY  
12 SERVICES AT THE SULZBACHER CENTER; PROVIDING FOR  
13 CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; REQUESTING  
14 ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN  
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,  
19 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
21 listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The funding above is an appropriation of \$100,000 from the  
31 Homelessness Initiatives Special Revenue Fund to the

1 General Fund Operating - Salaries Overtime account within  
2 the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office ("JSO") to provide  
3 funding to JSO for overtime salaries for the provision of  
4 security services at the Sulzbacher Center.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
6 Section 1 is to provide funds to cover overtime salaries for JSO  
7 officers to provide security at the Sulzbacher Center located at 611  
8 E. Adams Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202. The Sulzbacher Center  
9 has requested this service because of recent incidents that have  
10 occurred outside of their facility raising security concerns for the  
11 individuals who are served by the Sulzbacher Center and the employees  
12 who work at the center.

13 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated herein shall  
14 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

15 **Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**  
16 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this  
17 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to allow the  
18 security services to commence as soon as possible recognizing the  
19 Sulzbacher Center has already experienced employee turnover due to  
20 the incidents that have occurred outside the facility.

21 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
23 without the Mayor's signature.
