7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$150,000.00 IN GRANT
8 FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW
9 ENFORCEMENT, THROUGH ITS FY 23-24 STATE
10 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR FENTANYL ERADICATION
11 (S.A.F.E.) IN FLORIDA PROGRAM, TO THE PSBU
12 GRANTS/FENTANYL OVERDOSE DEATH INVESTIGATIONS
13 (FODI) PROJECT FY 23-24 TO COMBAT ILLEGAL
14 FENTANYL ACTIVITY, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-050;
15 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE
16 SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
31 funds from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement,

1 through its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for
2 Fentanyl Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to the
3 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office PSBU Grants/Fentanyl
4 Overdose Death Investigations (FODI) Project FY 23-24 to
5 combat illegal fentanyl activity. The grant period
6 commenced on July 1, 2023 and continues through June 30,
7 2024. No local match is required.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
9 Section 1 is to utilize the Fentanyl Overdose Death Investigations
10 (FODI) grant funding from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement
11 through its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for Fentanyl
12 Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to conduct investigations
13 designed to combat illegal fentanyl activity and will cover expenses
14 related to overtime for such investigations. A copy of the Grant
15 Award outlining the terms and conditions relative to the grant and
16 use of the grant funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and
17 incorporated herein by this reference.

18 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
19 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described
20 herein.

21 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
23 without the Mayor's signature.
