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## ORDINANCE 2024-466

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$785,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND - GSD PROPERTY TAX ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SUBSIDIES CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF NORTH FLORIDA, INC. ("GOODWILL"), FOR THE BUILDING FUTURES TOGETHER - A GOODWILL WORKFORCE TRAINING PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM"), AS MORE FULLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2025; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH GOODWILL; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH GOODWILL; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF NORTH FLORIDA, INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$785,000 from the General Fund - GSD Property Tax account to the General Fund Operating Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account to provide funding to Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc. ("Goodwill") for the Building Futures Together - A Goodwill Workforce Training Program (the "Program").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to Goodwill for the Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program will be administered by Goodwill in collaboration with Florida State College at Jacksonville (FSCJ) and the Home Builders Institute and is intended to fill a gap in current skilled trade educational offerings by providing industry-relevant courses and creating a pathway to sustainable employment and community enrichment. The Program will specifically target construction trades such as carpenters, plumbers, HVAC, electricians, welders and other related occupations which are experiencing a labor shortage. In addition to trade certifications,

the Program will offer GED training and other support and testing programs from FSCJ in coordination with wrap-around services offered by Goodwill.

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Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to September 30, 2025.

Section 4. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc. to administer the Program described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc. This waiver is justified because Goodwill currently provides a variety of wrap-around services, including various training and education programs, in coordination with a number of community partners and stakeholders. Goodwill is currently undertaking renovations at a facility to house the Program to ensure the site is appropriately outfitted to serve the mission and goals of the Program and its intended clients.

Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of

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the City an agreement with Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$785,000, subject to the Scope of Services and Budget more particularly described in **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing on July 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 7. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
