CM Morgan asked if the appointment of CM Diamond as liaison should be seperate from this bill. Lawsikia Hodges, Office of General Counsel, stated that there isn't any legal issue and it is up to the Council's discretion if they wanted to strike that part of the bill and create a stand alone piece of appointment legislation. CM Priestly Jackson made a motion to have the part that appoints CM Diamond as liaison amended. The three amendments were all rolled into one amendment.
