FACT SHEET IS REQUIRED BEFORE LEGISLATION IS INTRODUCED

OGC Rev. 10/11/2023 (LH)

In restructuring the Office of the Sheriff, the Sheriff seeks to change the title of assistant chiefs to section commanders. In doing so, changes to relevant portions of the City Charter and ordinance require changes for consistency. First, the City Charter section 17.06 (Applicability of Civil Service System to Employees of Consolidated Government), as authorized by section 17.06(ee), is changed to (1) rename appointed employees from assistant chiefs to section commanders, (2) include executive assistants for department directors that had not been included previously, and (3) remove the number of Sheriff aides and section commanders that can be appointed by the Sheriff. The appointed positions under this section will not have civil service protection. The Council must vote to approve by a majority plus one vote pursuant to section 17.06(ee). Second, the bill seeks amendment of Chapter 37 (Office of the Sheriff) to include the new title of "section commanders" instead of assistant chiefs and change the name of secretaries to executive assistants. Third, section 116.901, due to the new titles of appointed employees, the section will reflect same and status of exemption from Civil Service protection. Fourth, under Chapter 121 (Police and Firefighters Pension Plan), the bill seeks to add two classes of retirees to be exempted from sections 121.105(a) through (c). Lastly, amending Chapter 129 (Salaries of Public Officials and Employees) to make complimentary adjustment to the titles of appointed employees consistent with section 116.901.
