7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$1,069,280.01 URBAN
8 SEARCH AND RESCUE GRANT AWARDED BY THE STATE OF
9 FLORIDA, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT,
10 THROUGH ITS FISCAL YEAR 2022 URBAN SEARCH AND
11 RESCUE SUSTAINMENT PROGRAM TO PURCHASE VEHICLES,
12 CAPITAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES FOR THE URBAN
13 SEARCH AND RESCUE TASK FORCES, AS INITIATED BY
14 B.T. 23-021; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
15 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT,
16 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN
17 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
22 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
23 listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

31 The funding above represents an appropriation of a

1 \$1,069,280.01 Urban Search and Rescue Grant awarded by the
2 State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management, through
3 its Fiscal Year 2022 Urban Search and Rescue Sustainment
4 Program. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD)
5 will use the funds to purchase vehicles, capital equipment
6 and supplies for the Urban Search and Rescue Task Forces
7 (the "Task Forces"). The grant period of performance
8 commenced July 1, 2022 and ends June 30, 2023. No local
9 match is required.

10 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
11 Section 1 is to provide grant funding from the State of Florida,
12 Division of Emergency Management, to procure capital equipment,
13 supplies and vehicles for the Task Forces including, but not limited
14 to, an International 4-door Tractor, Command Vehicles (Tahoe or
15 similar), F350 and F450 Crew Cab Pickup Trucks, Kubota 4 passenger
16 utility vehicles, Featherlite flatbed dual-axel trailers, a pneumatic
17 compressor, and field repairable dry suits. This equipment will help
18 to ensure the Task Forces are maintained in a constant state of
19 readiness with the ability to immediately respond to any disaster,
20 whether natural or manmade. Each Task Force must maintain lifesaving
21 equipment and this grant funding will ensure it is up to date and
22 complete. A copy of the State-Funded Grant Agreement Urban Search
23 and Rescue Grant (Agreement Number: T0230) providing the terms and
24 conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds has
25 been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

26 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
27 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee
28 administration of the grant described herein.

29 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
31 without the Mayor's signature.
