

# Business Impact Estimate

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$75,000 FROM THE TRAFFIC CALMING – DISTRICT 08 – OTHER CONSTRUCTION COSTS ACCOUNT TO THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE FUND – ESP – OUT-OF-SCHOOL-TIME – SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF NORTH FLORIDA, INC. (“GOODWILL”) FOR THE SUMMER YOUTH WORKS PROGRAM (THE “PROGRAM”) AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; AMENDING THE SECOND REVISED SCHEDULE M TO ORDINANCE 2025-511-E; WAIVING SECTION 77.101 (LEGISLATIVE INTENT), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO AUTHORIZE USE OF THE CITY FUNDS APPROPRIATED HEREIN TO SERVE PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS BETWEEN 16 AND 24 YEARS OLD; WAIVING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111 (CONTRACTS; CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION; CARRYOVER), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY GOODWILL FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF NORTH FLORIDA, INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; AMENDING THE 2026-2030 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2025-505-E TO REFLECT THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE PROJECT ENTITLED “TRAFFIC CALMING-DISTRICT 08”; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY KHA; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
