5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$25,000 FROM THE SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE 6 7 SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG 8 ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO ARTIST CONNECTION 9 THEATRE, INC. ("ACT") FOR THE MAIN STAGE PROGRAM AND YOUNG ARTIST PROGRAM (COLLECTIVELY, THE 10 "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR 11 CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; WAIVING 12 SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING 13 THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), 14 15 PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT 16 CONTRACT WITH ACT; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING 17 THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION 18 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF 19 20 THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF 21 JACKSONVILLE AND ARTIST CONNECTION THEATRE, INC. 22 FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE 23 24 FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

27 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, 28 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 29 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 30 listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$25,000 from the Special Council Contingency account to the Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account to provide a grant to Artist Connection Theatre, Inc. ("ACT") for the Main Stage program and Young Artists program (collectively, the "Program") as described herein.

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 13 Section 2. Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to ACT 14 for the Program as described in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto and 15 incorporated herein by this reference. The Program is comprised of 16 17 two initiatives that include the Main Stage program through which ACT hosts and performs eight main stage productions during the 2025/2026 18 19 season and the Young Artists program, which is offered each summer 20 as a two-week, tuition-based workshop for kids ages eight to 17 years 21 old. The Young Artists program provides training for auditions and 22 education on acting and performance technology, culminating in a full weekend of performances by the program participants. The City funds 23 24 will be used to pay for maintenance and repairs to the ACT dressing rooms, with the remainder being used to pay for production royalty 25 26 fees and costs for supplies and materials for ACT's various 27 productions.

28 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall 29 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

30 Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The 31 provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through 1 a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), 2 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow 3 for a direct contract with Artist Connection Theatre, Inc. This 4 waiver is justified because ACT offers fun and interactive community-5 based theater programming for youth in Arlington and its surrounding 6 communities.

7 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation 8 9 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 10 the City a grant agreement with Artist Community Theatre, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$25,000, subject to the Term Sheet and Budget 11 more particularly described in **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing on 12 October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026, and all other contracts 13 and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the 14 agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate 15 the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and 16 approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the 17 City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and 18 19 indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, 20 Ordinance Code.

21 Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and 22 Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee 23 the project described herein.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
